  - Approved

- Review Year 5 financial projections
  - ASU \$350; SIU \$250
  - Dickey-john and Caterpillar have withdrawn membership
  - Hamilton Sundstrand now part of UTC Aerospace Systems
- Update: invention disclosures
  - Georgios Fainekos to send invention disclosure info to Rita
  - CES to notify NSF each time invention disclosure distributed and send documentation
  - CES to forward notifications to CES member list
- Update: FRP- thermal energy harvesting
  - This was the 2nd FRP submitted on behalf of CES, "Collaborative: Embedded Thermal Energy Harvesting System for Low Power Applications," and was rejected by the NSF because the IAB letter of support was unspecific
  - SV to work on a more specific letter on behalf of the IAB and work with members on support
  - Goal to resubmit: by January 2014
- Update on Phase II
  - Members to provide CES with letters of support. LC to provide IAB letter contact info and directions for member letters; letter deadline September 3

# **NEW BUSINESS**

- Discussion and vote on Northeastern University
  - Northeastern University, Boston, MA, <u>www.northeastern.edu</u>, is interested in joining CES as a 3<sup>rd</sup> academic site. Faculty members Fabrizio Lombardi and Yong-Bin Kim, Department of Electrical & Computer Engineering, are leading the application process.
  - Northeastern University intends to pursue these companies for membership: Analog, LTX, Teradyne, Broadcom, AMD, EMC, Qualcomm, Bose, BAE Systems, Boston Scientific, Seagate, Cisco, Oracle.
  - Discussion on background of school, application process for a new academic site, potential
    members; and clarification about the vote at hand: that the IAB will not have another
    opportunity to vote to accept or reject Northeastern's request to join the center.
  - Proposed vote: Is the IAB receptive to Northeastern applying for a planning grant to join the Center for Embedded Systems?
  - Approved: with one abstain vote from Toyota
  - Concern expressed about the following issues: the companies that will join, that competitors will be involved; that the Center may lose focus with the addition of another school and its

members; and about the time commitment required of the IAB to read proposals and be versed on an increased number of research projects.

# Update on CES website security

- In response to IAB member concerns about the security of the existing website, a new CES website will be launched in this summer, hosted by ASU for increased security.
- Members will access the secure site with "ASUrite" credentials assigned by ASU and individual access / passwords for each individual at each member company.
- ASUrite assignments will involve a two-step process: 1) IAB members to provide Lisa Christian with full name and birthdate, 2) Lisa will enter this data in the ASU system that will generate a an email directly to each member, with instructions for login and password setup.
