

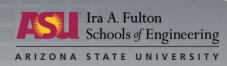

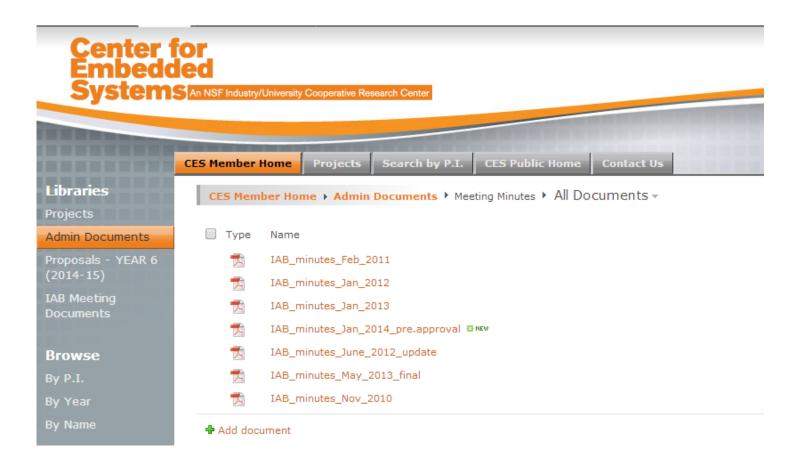

Voting Logistics

Industry Voting:

- Each industry vote represents \$5K/vote
- Industry members should prioritize their research proposal 1st when distributing votes
- Industry members could collaborate amongst themselves for project voting
- Outcome of the votes defines the industry priorities of the research proposals (by university)

University Site Directors role:

- Directors distribute research funds based on industry priorities
- Directors are given the flexibility to work with the Pl's on actual vs proposed funding
- Directors work together to ensure projects which a majority of industry members show interest are funded
- Directors publish final "Approved Project" list to all industry members
